



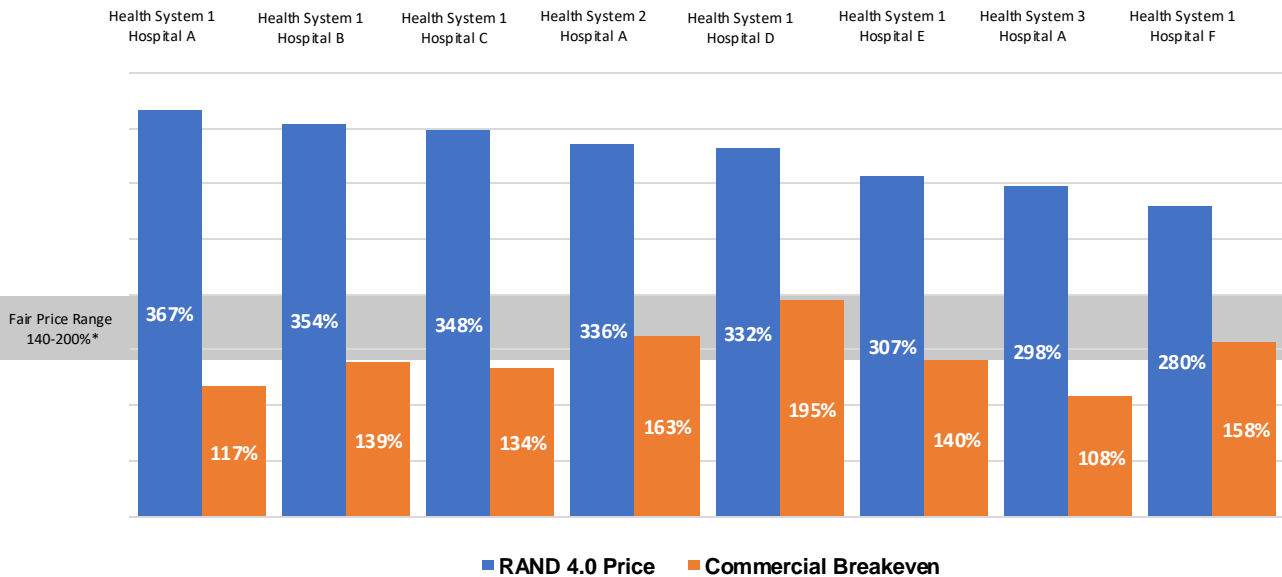

RAND vs National Academy for State Health Policy Commercial Breakeven for Five-Star Hospitals

Price vs. Cost Comparison by Hospital

How much a hospital should charge commercial payers to breakeven with Medicare compared to what RAND found commercial payers are charged through claims analysis.



RAND 4.0 Price Negotiated amount paid to hospitals by commercial payers.

Commercial Breakeven Payment level required from commercial payers (expressed as a percentage of Medicare rates) to allow the hospital to cover maximum hospital expenses, with no profit, for hospital inpatient and outpatient services.
